4. <u>GENERAL ISSUES/FINANCE</u>

A. <u>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CODE AMENDMENT</u>

City Attorney Matthew Kolling stated he revised the alcoholic beverage ordinance based upon discussions at the last City Commission meeting. He stated he elimated all reference of ownership percentage and removed the restriction that a person can only own one on/off sale alcoholic beverage license. Commissioner Steiner stated the revised ordinance is the direction the City should proceed and suggested the City hold a public hearing prior to consideration of second reading and final passage.

MOTION BY: Carson Steiner SECONDED BY: Bill Reitmeier To approve first reading (and waiver thereof) of Ordinance No. 1346 and direct staff to advertise a public hearing on this ordinance during the December 17th meeting.

ORDINANCE NO. 1346

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTIONS 4.08.100 AND 4.08.120 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF DICKINSON, NORTH DAKOTA RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

DISCUSSION: President Johnson asked City Attorney Kolling if the amendment would allow a person to own all on/off sale alcoholic beverage licenses issued by the City. Attorney Kolling stated with the amendment, a person could own all licenses. City Administrator Sund stated the City Commission would still have the authority to reject a transfer if they chose to limit the number of license one person could own. President Johnson directed staff to schedule a public hearing for December 17th.

8. <u>ADMINISTRATION:</u>

A. CITY ADMINISTRATOR REPORT:

1. Board/Committee Member terms expiring as of 12-31-07:

City Administrator Sund referenced a list in the agenda packets of those City boards/committees which have member terms expiring at the end of the year. He stated some of the members have not indicated whether they desire reappointment but staff will continue to follow up with those individuals and will forward a list of names to the city Commission for future appointments. On behalf of the City Commission, President Johnson thanked all members who have dedicated their time to be on a City board/committee.

2. 2008 Regular Meeting Schedule:

Sund stated a list of 2008 Regular City Commission Meeting dates were included in the packet for reference.

3. Credit Card Use Policy:

Sund stated following the City 2005 audit, he drafted a General Purchase and Credit Card Use Policy and implemented it as internal policy with senior management. He stated since implementation, the Auditors have indicated their preference the policy be approved by the City Commission. Sund stated if there were no Commission objections, he would present the policy for consideration for approval on the December 17th agenda. No Commissioners voiced objection.

4. National Citizen Survey:

Sund stated he received information from the ICMA Newsletter regarding the National Citizen Survey. He stated ICMA and the National Research Center, Inc. is a low-cost citizen survey service for local governments. He stated if the City chooses to move forward with an update to the Creating our Destiny study which was done in 1999 and 2000, the National Citizen Survey would be a good start. Johnson noted according to the article, the cost would be \$8,900.

9. <u>ACCOUNTS PAYABLE AND PAYROLL</u>

10. <u>CITY COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS:</u>

1. City Administrator Salary Adjustment:

President Johnson stated he and Commissioner Steiner reviewed Administrator Sund's compensation. He stated it is their opinion that the City Administrator's salary is below market and that a market adjustment along with a cost of living and performance adjustment warrants an increase of \$5,000 to an annualized salary of \$85,000 effective

December 1, 2007 and an additional \$5,000 to an annualized salary of \$90,000 effective as of June 1, 2008. Commissioner Steiner stated they compared Sund's salary with 11 North Dakota and five South Dakota cities and the Dickinson Public Schools and believes with the \$10,000 increase they are getting the City Administrator salary where it should be based on market. Commissioner Reitmeier stated he felt a \$10,000 increase was substantial and preferred the increase be spread over a two year period. Frenzel stated the proposed increase is significant but it is time for the City to pay what they should for the position. Johnson stated Mr. Sund has a Masters Degree in public administration, has received his ICMA accreditation and was a past City Commissioner in the state of South Dakota.

MOTION BY: Joe Frenzel SECONDED BY: Carson Steiner To accept Johnson and Steiner's recommendation and increase City Administrator Greg Sund's salary by \$5,000 to an annualized salary of \$85,000 effective December 1, 2007 and an additional \$5,000 to an annualized salary of \$90,000 effective June 1, 2008.

DISCUSSION: Commissioner Reitmeier stated while he does not agree with a \$10,000 increase for Administrator Sund, it is not because of the job he does but that it is too big of a step at one time.

DISPOSITION: Roll call vote...Aye 3, Nay 1 (Reitmeier), Absent 1 (Dukart)
