



NO TRAVEL ADVISED

Community Members,

The City of Dickinson has issued a No Travel Advisory due to the worsening road and visibility conditions. Due to the decreased visibility, the City of Dickinson will be shutting down plowing operations until visibility conditions improve, due to traffic safety concerns.

As weather and visibility conditions improve, the City of Dickinson Public Works Department will resume their plowing operations in an effort to clear Level 1 and Level 2 Snow Routes for Public Safety personnel before moving on to clear neighborhoods and the Downtown districts.

As the storm progresses, monitor local media and City of Dickinson social media platforms for travel advisories and restrictions. Travel should be restricted to emergencies only. If you must travel, have a winter survival kit with you. Notify a friend or family member of your travel plans. If you get stranded, stay with your vehicle. If you live along an emergency snow route, please move your vehicles from the street as this greatly assists road crews in keeping vital roadways open for emergency vehicle response.
