

A penalty fee will be assessed to ALL unsecured loads received at the baler building or landfill. Loads must be secured in a manner that renders the load incapable of losing debris. Tarp or tie--with the tailgate closed if possible.

Examples of properly secured loads:

- Cardboard, paper, plastics, trash bags = Tarped
- Construction/Demolition debris = Tarped
- Tree Branches = Tied down
- Long deck/fence boards = Tied down

All loads will be evaluated UPON ARRIVAL AT THE SCALE at the scale operator's discretion to ensure compliance with this policy.

Penalty fees for unsecured loads:

Up to 8 ft. long container - \$35

8 ft. – 16 ft. long container - \$50

16 ft. or longer - \$75

Tips for securing you load:

- Use tarps, netting, etc. when transporting small or light weight materials
- Put lighter weight items at the bottom of the load
- Use ratchet straps, tie downs, bungee cords, etc. for large, heavy items.
- Tie larger items directly to your vehicle
- Do not over load the vehicle
- Use a tailgate when possible
