C. Election Signs

City Administrator Joe Gaa discusses temporary civic signs and advanced election signs which are put in yards at this time of the election. The City of Dickinson currently has 30 days prior to election to place your signs on private property. Administrator Gaa would like to be consistent with the State at this time to allow these signs to be placed in yards as of date. Administrator Gaa is encouraging people to vote. He states individuals who have voted in the past will receive cards from the State and will be able to vote starting May 1, 2020.
