

Noticing Discolored Water?



The City of Dickinson recently performed service work in the Downtown area that distributes drinking water using cast iron pipes. Cast iron is susceptible to rusting.

What you need to know:

The primary quality of your water is unaffected. It is safe to consume. It is the secondary quality that has been affected, which is the taste and color of the water. The discoloration of the water will subside over time as water runs through the pipes. Please avoid washing any light-colored clothing until your water clears.
