In order to facilitate a safe and effective snow removal process during the current conditions, Public Works crews have continued to focus on clearing the Level 1 and Level 2 Emergency snow routes as well as problematic roadways throughout the city. If possible, please remove parked vehicles from roadways in order to assist the efficiencies of the snow removal process.

If you decide to venture out, please exercise caution on the roadways as they are coated with snow and ice due to the current weather conditions. We kindly ask for your patience and understanding as we work diligently to better serve the citizens of Dickinson.

Tomorrow morning, Public Works crews along with several contractors will begin to focus on residential areas around 8 am. Please contact Public Works at 456-7979 for any questions or concerns.

If you have a fire hydrant on your property, we ask that you plan on clearing the snow around the hydrant to ensure it is accessible in the event of an emergency.
